She has also had numerous one-person shows throughout New England, and is represented by the Tidemark Gallery. She also has a studio gallery on Back Cove Road in Waldoboro.

We will paint outdoors at various locations along the Medomak River, weather permitting. In bad weather we will meet in the

VFW Hall, or other location.

Cost: \$140.00, \$35.00 deposit required to reserve spot. The balance due by August 10.

Class Size: Class is limited to 8 students. A minimum of 3 students is required for the class to meet.

Cancellation Policy:

More than 7 days—full refund

Less than 7 days—\$15.00 fee

If Recreation Department cancels the class, full refund.

MATERIALS LIST

Paper: A good 140 lb. paper is the key to a successful painting. I recommend Arches, Waterford, Windsor Newton or other quality watercolor papers, or blocks available locally or on-line.

Paints: Inexpensive paint sets are fine. I have used Prang and Niji with good results. Or you may use tube colors. We want to have both a warm and a cool of the primary hues:

- A cool yellow, e.g., Lemon Yellow
- A warm yellow, e.g., Indian Yellow, Gamboge, Yellow Ochre
- A cool red, e.g., Rose Red
- A warm red, e.g., Permanent Red
- A cool blue, e.g., Cerulean Blue, Cobalt Blue, Pthalo Blue
- A warm blue, e.g., Ultramarine Blue

Accessories to bring:

- A plastic palette for mixing colors
- A container to hold water for paint mixing
- A container for water to clean brushes
- Paper towels
- Bug repellent and sun block
- A lunch along with water to drink (you need to stay hydrated)
- We will be outdoors, so dress accordingly
